



**ISN is pleased to announce a new special
Fellowship Training Opportunity in collaboration with the
Turkish Society of Nephrology**

The Turkish Society of Nephrology awards research and clinical Fellowships to young Turkish nephrologists in eminent nephrology centers in the developed world. The grant for 12 months of training amounts to USD 18,000.

ISN - TSN Fellowship:

The successful candidate that has won a TSN grant, and is thus preparing for his training abroad, may seek further financial assistance by the ISN. S/he may apply to the ISN Fellowship Program according to the program's guidelines and selection procedures, and, provided s/he is accepted, will receive an additional amount of USD 2,000 to 6,000 by the ISN, depending on the cost of living in the host city.

Required application documents:

In addition to the application documents submitted to the Turkish Society of Nephrology (host institution's letter of acceptance and training/research plan in English) the candidate is required to submit the following documents:

- ISN Fellowship application form
- CV (of maximum four pages)
- Applicant's letter describing the goals and objectives and how the training is to benefit the home country and institution
- Letter of Endorsement by the Turkish Society of Nephrology

After completion of the training and the return to Turkey, the candidate needs to submit an end-of-training form to the ISN.

The candidate will be endorsed 'ISN-TSN Fellow' and will receive the regular end-of-training benefits granted to ISN Fellows.
